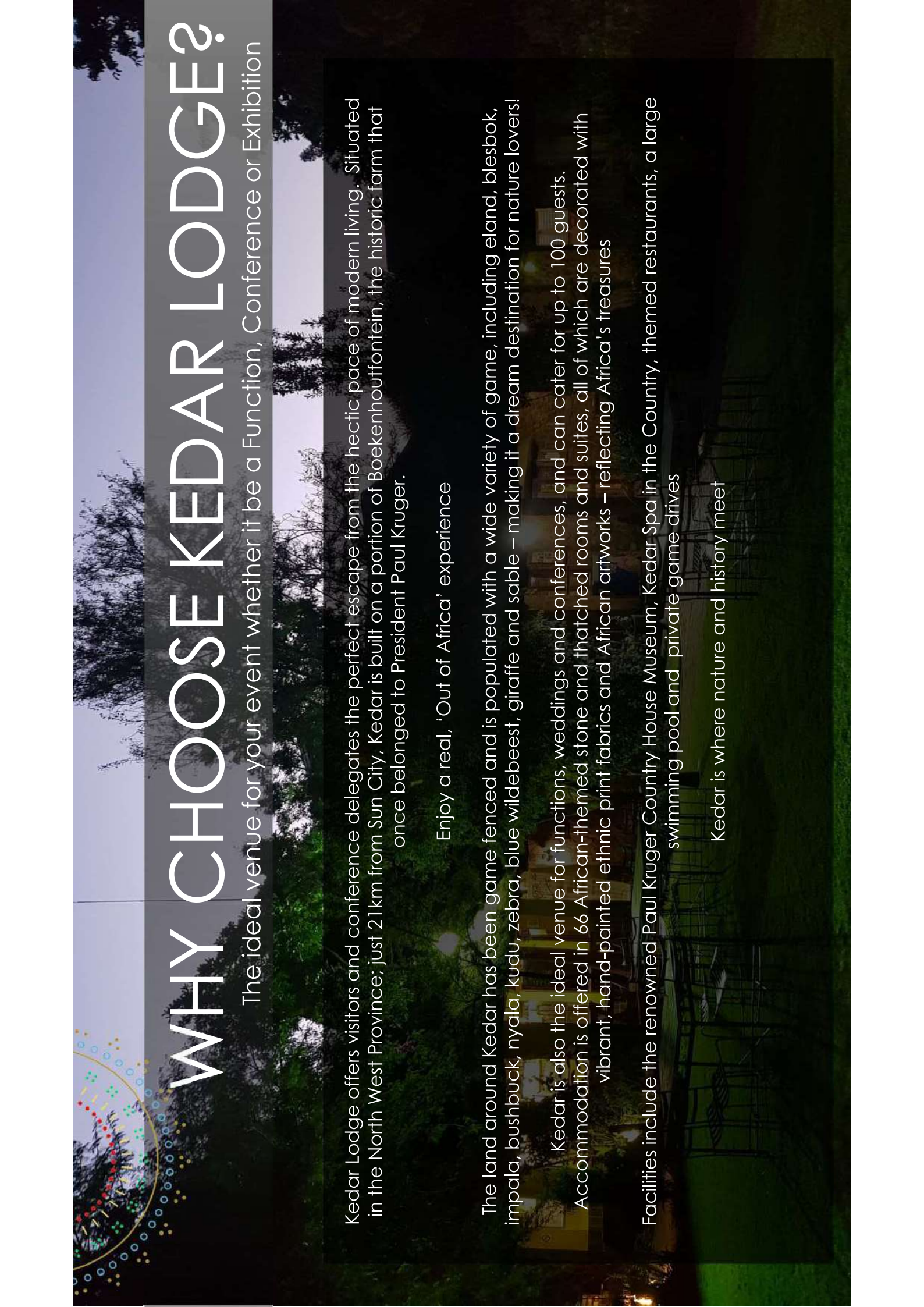

LAKE SIDE SUITES

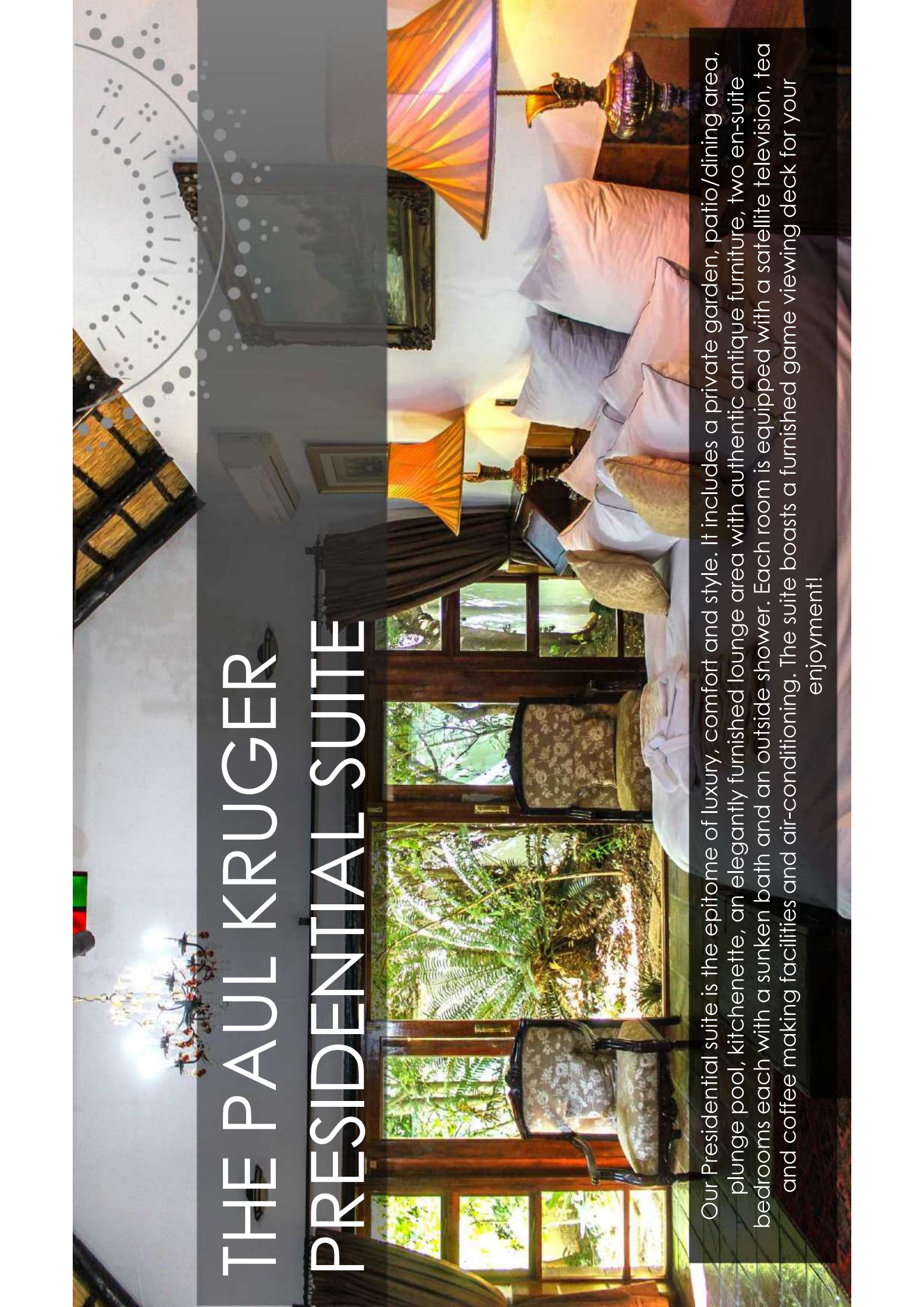

The suite boasts a furnished game viewing deck for your enjoyment!



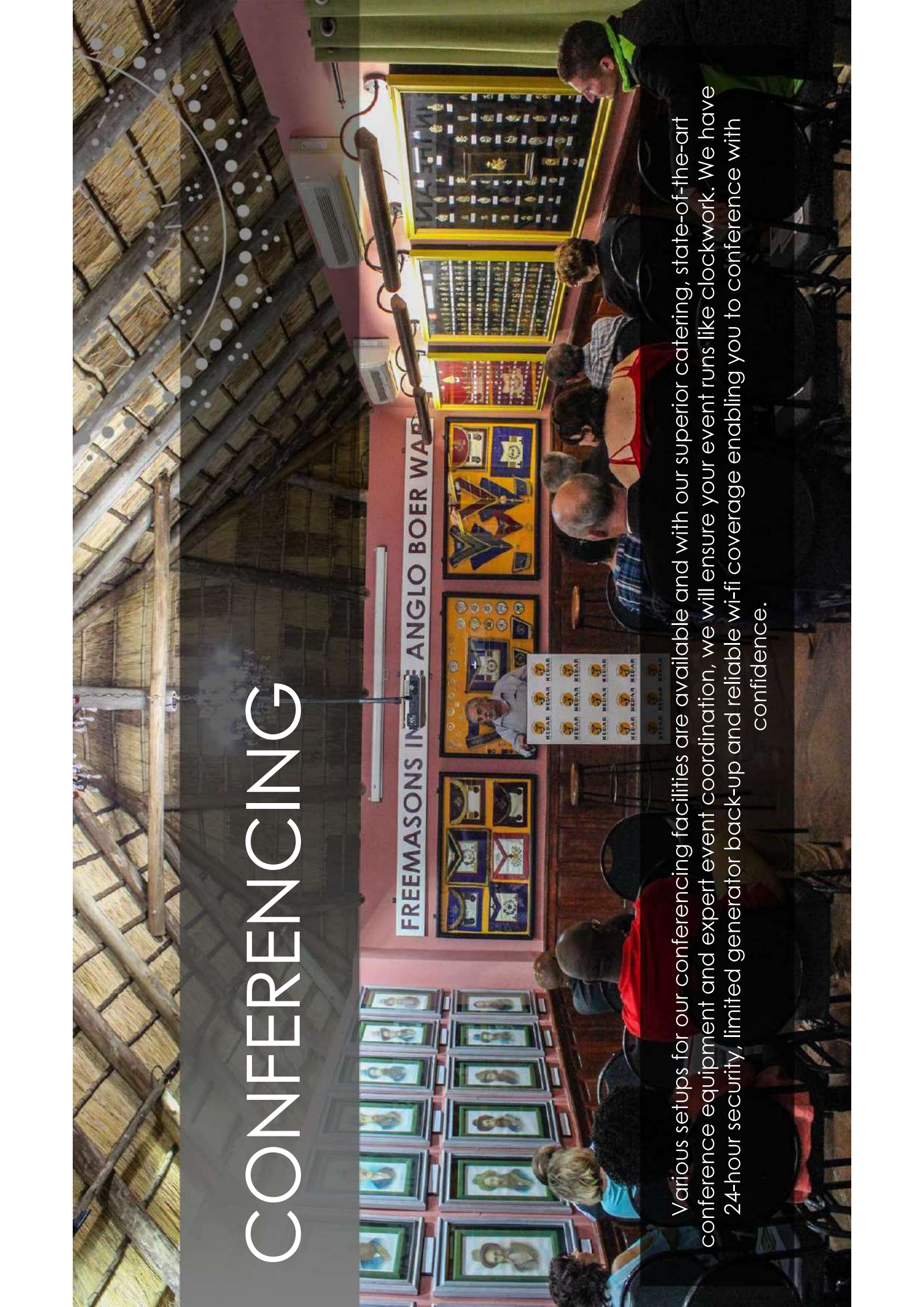
THE PAUL KRUGER PRESIDENTIAL SUITE

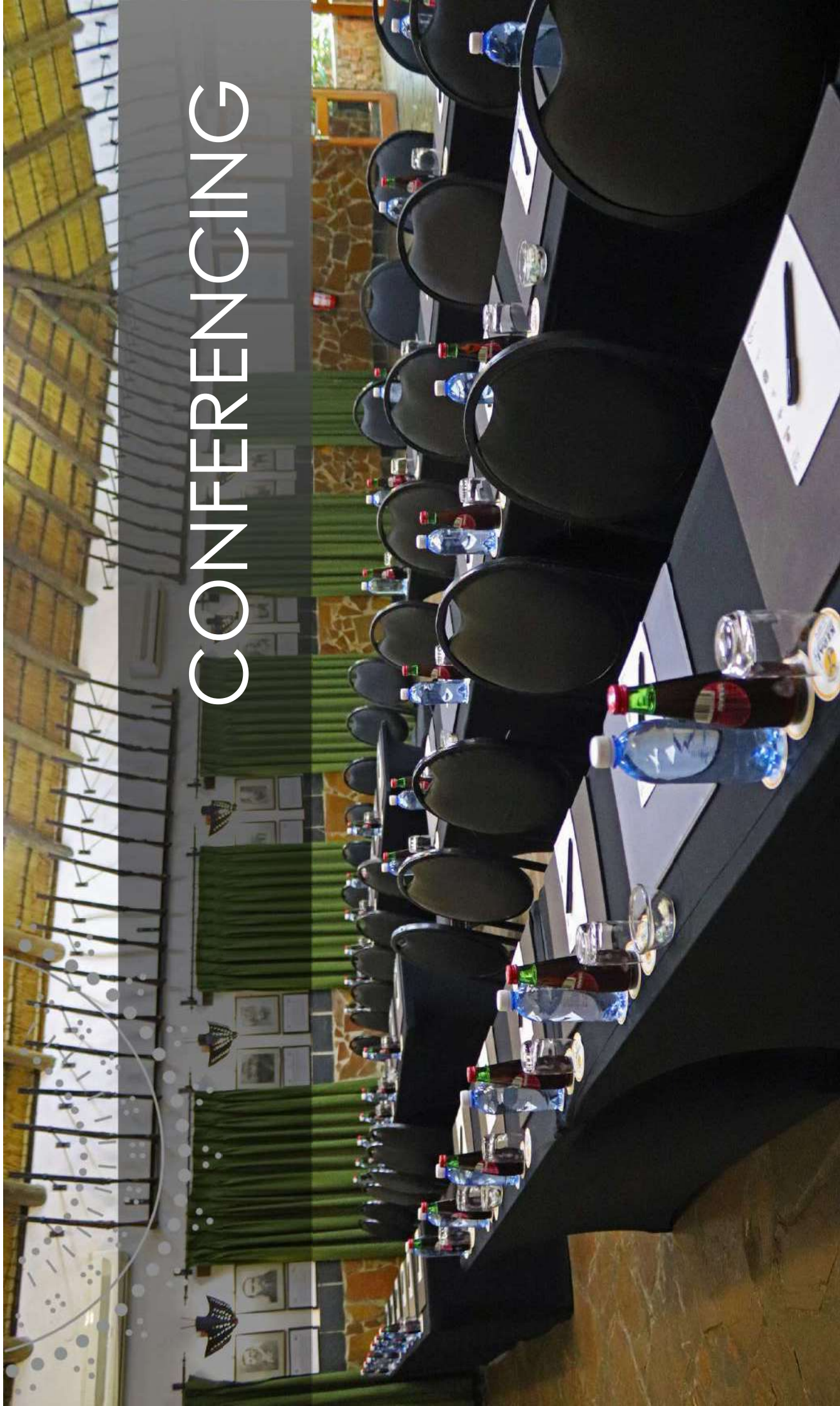

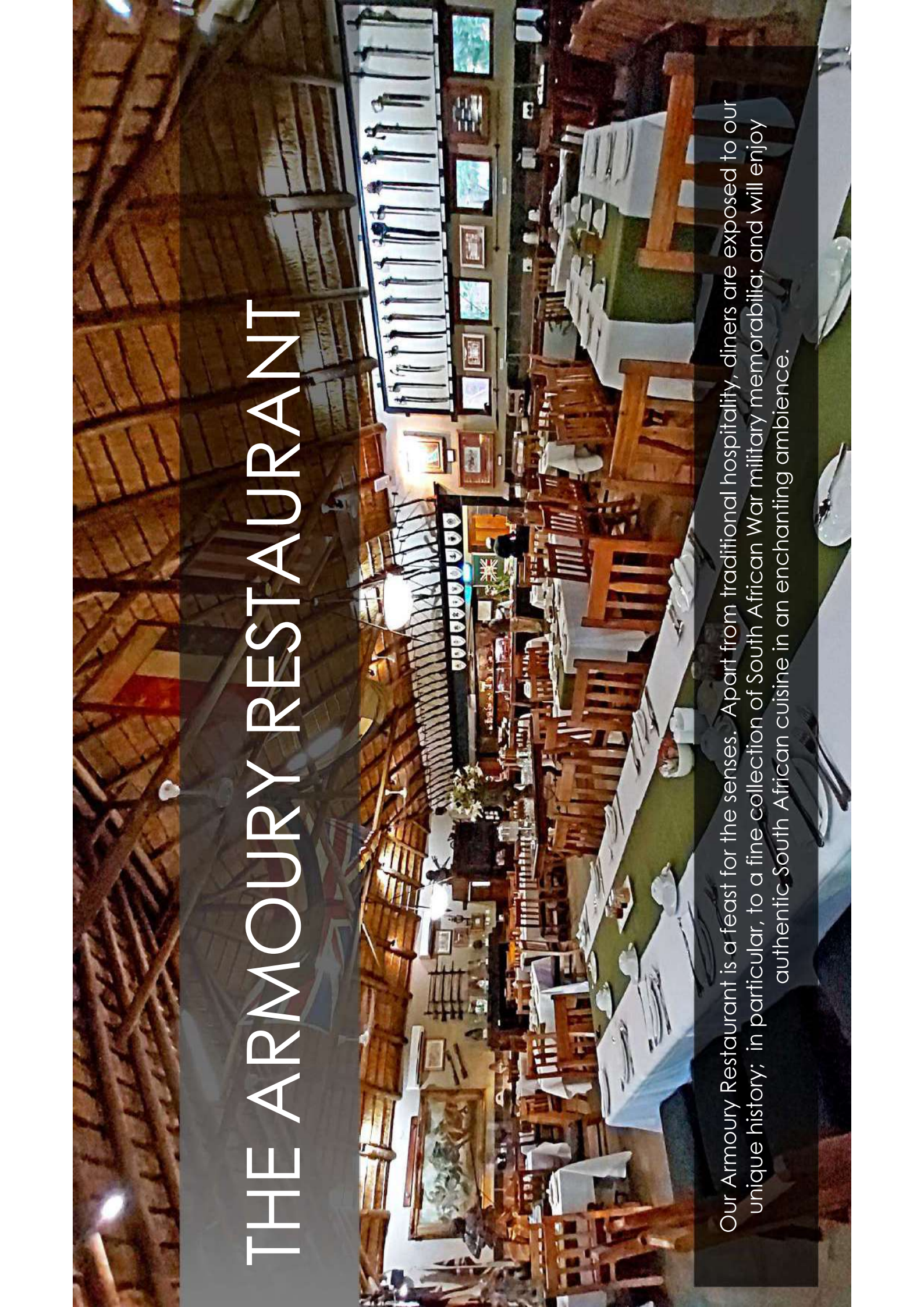

THE BOMA

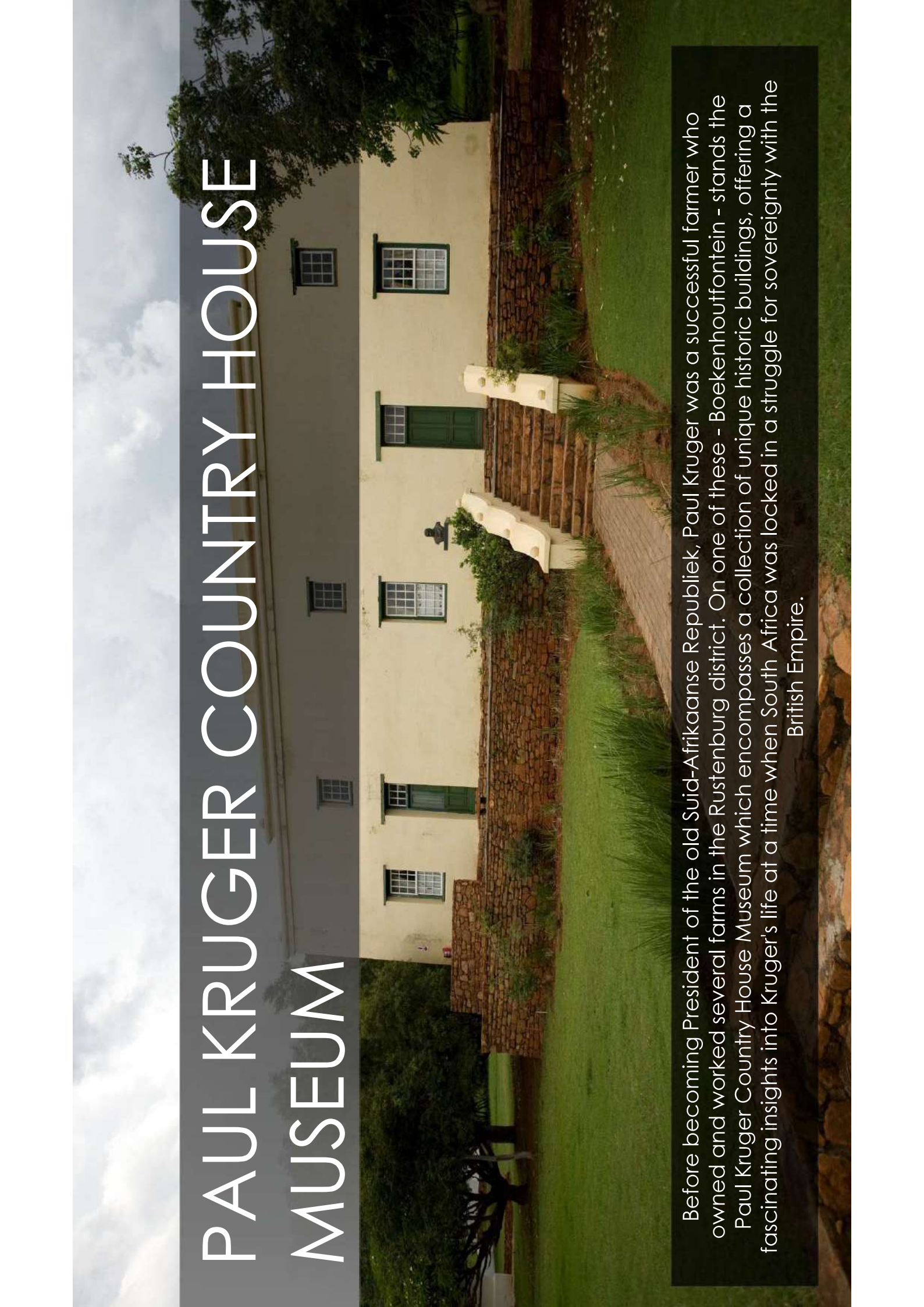

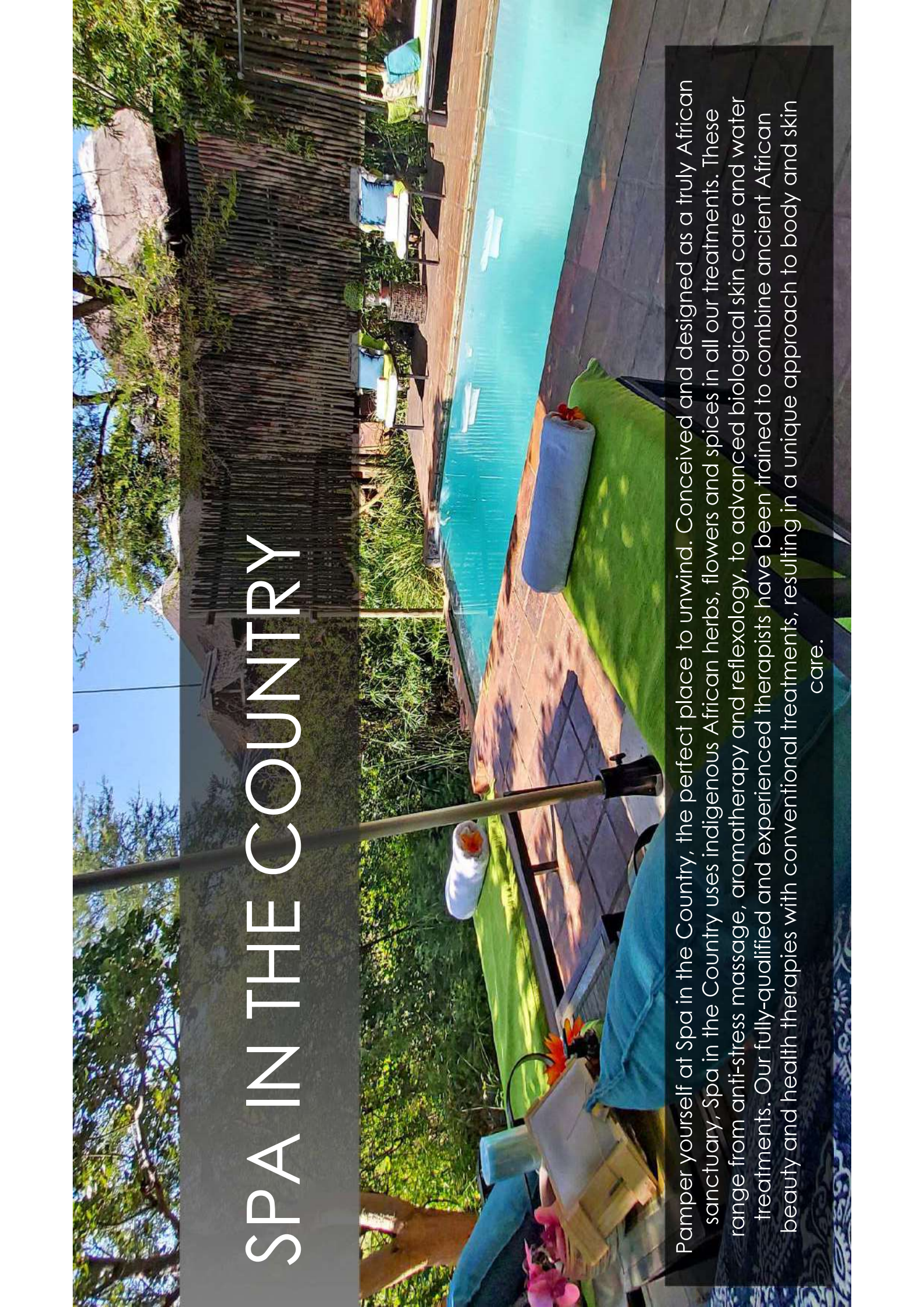
PAUL KRUGER COUNTRY HOUSE MUSEUM

Before becoming President of the old Suid-Afrikaanse Republiek, Paul Kruger was a successful farmer who owned and worked several farms in the Rustenburg district. On one of these - Boekenhoutfontein - stands the Paul Kruger Country House Museum which encompasses a collection of unique historic buildings, offering a fascinating insights into Kruger's life at a time when South Africa was locked in a struggle for sovereignty with the British Empire.

SPA IN THE COUNTRY

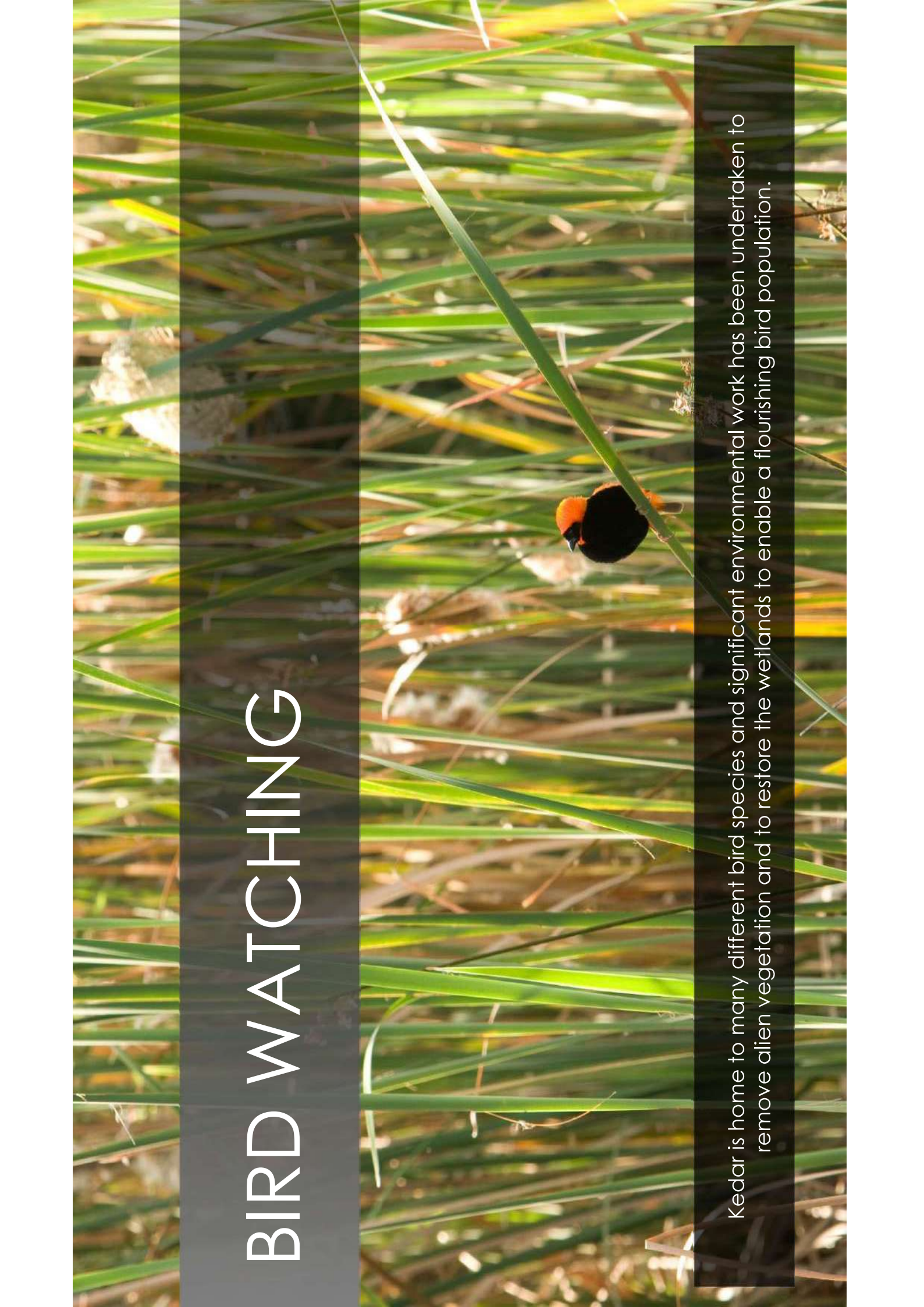
